ORDER

As per Government order read as 1st paper above, a scheme named 'Kerala Specific Angel Fund' was sanctioned as part of the Youth Entrepreneurship Development Program (YEDP). The scheme was introduced to bring in more funds to the Kerala based Startups by investing in alternative investment funds having accreditation of SEBI. Accordingly, the scheme was started with investing in the two funds selected through a process. In the second phase, three funds were selected and investments in the funds are in progress.

The Chief Executive Officer, Kerala Startup Mission as per letter read as 2nd paper above proposed two committees namely Investment Committee and Disinvestment Committee for the purpose of investment in the 'Kerala Specific Angel Fund' and to deal with the disinvestment proposals.
