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I. Introduction on Kerala Startup Mission (KSUM)

Kerala Startup Mission, the nodal agency to the Government of Kerala for promoting entrepreneurship in the state, is also the implementing body for the Kerala Technology Startup Policy that supports the state's startup ecosystem through the various schemes and support programs.

KSUM invites technical and financial proposals from contractors for plumbing modification and upgrade works at the Integrated Startup Complex (ISC), including improvements to the existing plumbing system to support treated water usage, in compliance with relevant standards and safety requirements.

II. Purpose of Tender

This tender document is being prepared to provide details about the scope of work, expectations from the agency, and bidding procedure and can be downloaded from <https://startupmission.kerala.gov.in/tenders>. III. Site Details

The site is a building (ISC) within the Kerala Technology Innovation Zone at Kalamassery. ISC building is 1.87 lakh sqft building situated in the 13.2 acre of KTIZ within Kinfra Hi-tech Park. Integrated Startup Complex (ISC) comprises G+4 storeys with three lower basement levels and consists of Tower 1 and Tower 2. Both towers have separate terraces. The terrace area of Tower 1 is 1,285 sqm, while the terrace area of Tower 2 is 282 sqm. Each tower is provided with an independent fire water tank. The domestic water tank is located in Tower 1, and the sewage treated water tank is situated in Basement Level 3.

Both terraces accommodate ac outdoor units, with associated piping routed through the floor level and supported on concrete blocks. And flush tanks on both tower sides and ducts on each floor level.

IV. Scope of Work

- New overflow line from fire tank-1 to 2 and further overflow to domestic tank
- Cleaning of Fire tanks and flush tanks
- Dismantling of existing bypass connection between domestic and flush lines
- Dismantling of existing bypass connection between domestic and flush lines
- Replacing all ARV's at terrace level
- Providing NRV at fire pumping lines
- Providing and fixing uPVC Pipes, from STP treated water tank to OHT line.
- Covering the existing pipe lines with sand for protection against breaking

V. Eligibility and Pre-qualification Criteria of Bidder

The Bidder shall meet the prequalification criteria as specified in the NIT.

- 1.1. The bidder must hold a valid registration and submit an attested true copy of the registration certificate along with the bid submission.
- 1.2. The intending Bidder must have in his name as a prime contractor experience of having successfully completed at least one work of similar nature of contract value not less than **Rs. 5,00,000/-** or two works each of value not less than **Rs. 3,00,000/-** within the last five (5) years ending the last day of month previous to the month in which bid applications are invited for KSUM, Technopark, KINFRA or other reputed parks, PSUs or other reputed private organizations.
- 1.3. Bidders should have achieved Average Annual Turnover equal to 75% of the PAC in any 3 years within the last 5 years. For this purpose of determining the Turn Over the Revenue of the bidder alone shall be considered. The bidder should produce latest solvency certificate obtained within a period of six months for an amount equivalent to 50% of PAC or more obtained from Tahasildar/Nationalised/Scheduled Bank or Net worth certificate issued by a Chartered accountant along with the bid so as to what extent they are solvent.
- 1.4. The bidder should be making average profit in each of the last three financial years.
- 1.5. Information regarding any current litigation or arbitration proceedings in which the Bidder is involved. If such details are not there for a Bidder, he shall submit a Nil statement with regard to this.
- 1.6. Any Applicant should have, during the last three years, neither failed to perform on any agreement, as evidenced by imposition of a penalty by an arbitral or judicial authority or a judicial pronouncement or arbitration award against the Applicant, nor been expelled from any project or agreement nor have had any agreement terminated for breach by such applicant. The attention of the bidder is drawn to the fact that the quotation documents are not transferable. **(Document to be submitted is declaration in company letter head signed and sealed by the authorized signatory).**
- 1.7. Any entity that has been barred by Central /State Governments in India, any entity controlled by them, from participating in any project, and the bar subsists as on the date of proposal, would not be eligible to submit a

proposal.

- 1.8. The bidder neither failed to perform on any agreement, as evidenced by imposition of a penalty by an arbitral or judicial authority or a judicial pronouncement or arbitration award against the bidder during the last three years, nor been expelled from any project or agreement nor have had any agreement terminated for breach by such bidder.
- 1.9. Application from joint venture, consortium firms will not be accepted.
- 1.10. Information regarding any current litigation or arbitration proceedings in which the Bidder is involved. If such details are not there for a Bidder, he shall submit a Nil statement with regard to this
- 1.11. The attention of the bidder is drawn to the fact that the tender documents are not transferable. The Employer/ Tender inviting authority reserves the right to reject any or all the prequalification applications, without assigning any reason and the Employer's decision shall be final and binding to all concerned.
- 1.12. The applicant is expected to have visited the Work site before submitting Prequalification.
- 1.13. The attention of the bidder is drawn to the fact that the tender documents are not transferable. The Employer/ Tender inviting authority reserves the right to reject any or all the prequalification applications, without assigning any reason and the Employer's decision shall be final and binding to all concerned.

VI. Conditions of Contract

1. The KSUM may, at his discretion, decide to execute various works under different works contract packages or club some of these into one package and the contractor shall render their work accordingly.
2. The contractor shall meet all expenses towards the salary, traveling and other expenses of his staff.
3. The contractor shall carry out the work as per the instructions provided by KSUM or the designated Project Management CONTRACTOR (PMC), and strictly adhere to the agreed time schedule. In the event of any undue delay, KSUM reserves the right to terminate the contract at its sole discretion and reassign the unexecuted portion of the work to another agency. The contractor shall be entitled to payment only for the portion of work satisfactorily completed up to the date of such termination.

4. Contractor shall exercise all reasonable skill, care and diligence in the discharge of duties hereby covenanted to be performed by him and shall coordinate with Project Management CONTRACTOR (Appointed by KSUM) for smooth execution of the project.
5. Any reference to any legal Act, Government Policies or orders shall be deemed to include all amendments to such instruments, from time to time is applicable in this contract.
6. The contractor shall make their own arrangement for office accommodation for the staff deployed at sites/ locations. *Accommodation for staff/workers will not be permitted in the site premises.*

7. Suspension & Termination

- a. The contract herein may be terminated at any time on 1 months' notice on either side. In the event of the termination of the contract by KSUM, the CONTRACTOR shall not be entitled to any compensation or damage by reason of such termination, but only to the fees for the WORK actually rendered up to the time of such termination as decided by the KSUM or his representative.
- b. This contract shall be deemed to have been automatically terminated on the expiry of the contract period unless KSUM has exercised its option to extend this contract in accordance with the provisions, if any, of this Agreement.
- c. KSUM shall have the right to suspend partly or as a whole of the contract at any time the performance of WORK by notice of at least 30 days to CONTRACTOR , in such event, the contractor shall not be entitled to any compensation. KSUM shall pay to CONTRACTOR costs incurred for the works actually rendered.
- d. If KSUM considers that the performance of the CONTRACTOR is unsatisfactory or, not up to the expected standard, KSUM shall notify the CONTRACTOR in writing and specify in detail the cause of such dissatisfaction. KSUM shall have the option to terminate this CONTRACT by giving 30 days' notice in writing to the CONTRACTOR, if CONTRACTOR fails to comply with the requisitions contained in the said written notice issued by the KSUM.
- e. In the event of the failure of the CONTRACTOR to completely do his work within a reasonable time and in a satisfactory manner or in the event of the CONTRACTOR committing a breach of any one or more of the terms and conditions of the contract, KSUM shall be entitled to rescind the

contract without prejudice to his rights to claim damages or other rights or remedies under the law.

- f. If the CONTRACTOR shall close his business or die or become incapacitated from acting as such a CONTRACTOR as aforesaid, or if this contract is terminated KSUM may make use of all or any drawings, estimates or other documents prepared by the CONTRACTOR, after payment for the same, as provided herein.

8. Transfer of Interests

The CONTRACTOR shall not sublet or transfer their interest in this contract or appoint another sub-CONTRACTOR for works connected with this contract, without the written consent of KSUM. If the CONTRACTOR decides to engage the WORK of other agencies as sub-CONTRACTOR for any WORK, prior approval of the KSUM shall be obtained and the CONTRACTOR shall meet all expenses for the same; The CONTRACTOR shall be primarily responsible for all the WORK rendered by the sub CONTRACTOR.

9. Period of Contract

The period of contract shall be for 2 months from the date of commencement of work. If both parties agree, the contract will be extended further on the same and mutually agreed terms and conditions. The period of completion for work under the scope shall be mutually agreed upon as per a time schedule to be prepared within ten days from the date of the Agreement. If the period of completion for any work gets extended beyond the agreed period due to delay directly and solely attributable to the CONTRACTOR, liquidated damages at the rate of 0.5% of work fee per week of delay will be levied subject to a maximum of 5% of contract amount. If such delay exceeds 10 weeks, the KSUM reserves the right to offload the work from the CONTRACTOR and get it done through other agencies.

10. Performance guarantee

- a. The successful CONTRACTOR shall submit a Performance Guarantee for an amount equal to 5% of the total work fee (including GST) which shall be calculated on the basis of project cost within 14 days of award of the work and shall execute the agreement. Performance guarantee shall be valid for work completion period + 30 days (2 months + 30 days).
- b. If the successful bidder fails to furnish the required Performance Guarantees enter into contract, within 14 days of issue of work order, without a valid reason, further ten days' time will be allowed at the

request of the bidder, for which the successful bidder has to remit a fine equal to 1% of the Contract price as per his quote amount subject to a minimum of Rs.1,000/- and maximum of Rs.25,000/-.After submitting performance guarantees, the successful bidder has to execute an agreement with Agreement Authority in the format prescribed by the Authority. The Value of the stamp paper shall be 0.1% of contract value, minimum of Rs.500/- and maximum of Rs.1 Lakh.

- c. At least Fifty percent(50%) of Performance Guarantee shall be in the form of Treasury Fixed Deposit in the name of Agreement Authority for a period not less than 28 (twenty-eight) days after the completion of defect liability period and balance Performance Guarantee in the form of bank guarantee. Bank Guarantee is to be submitted in the format prescribed by the Employer in the bid document. Bank Guarantee shall be unconditional and it shall be from any Nationalised Bank/Scheduled Bank to be submitted before executing agreement and shall be valid till 28(twenty-eight) days after the completion of defect liability of the Work, in approved format. The Bank Guarantee on instalment basis with a lesser period of validity shall not be accepted.

11.Guarantees by the CONTRACTOR

- i. The CONTRACTOR shall guarantee that all works under their scope will be done in a most diligent manner as per terms of contract, standard practice and relevant codes and the interests of KSUM.TheCONTRACTOR further guarantees that, any loss /damage suffered by KSUM consequent to any act of omission / commission / negligence on the part of the CONTRACTOR shall be fully compensated by the CONTRACTOR .
- ii. CONTRACTOR shall guarantee that the WORK as specified/described under the scope of CONTRACTOR in the contract and technical documents to be developed shall be in accordance with sound and established engineering practices, using Indian Codes, Regulations and International Standards wherever applicable, for the purpose(s) specified, free from defects and suitable for respective uses intended.

11. Settlement of Disputes : All efforts shall be made to settle disputes if any arising out of and during the course of this contract by mutual discussion. If the dispute is not resolved, in the event of the necessity for any of the parties to file a suit, the suit shall be filed only in Trivandrum courts

12. Force Majeure : Neither the contractor nor the KSUM will be held responsible for any failure or delay in performance under this contract if the failure / delay is caused by any natural calamity, strike, curfew, riot, war or any act of god which prevents normal activities or orders or requisitions issued by a Govt. department or competent authority. If the force majeure condition affects completion schedule, the time of completion shall be revised to the extent of affected period.

13. Payment Terms :

1. The payment to the Contractor for the performance of the works under the Contract will be made by the Employer as per the guidelines and conditions specified herein. All payments made during the Contract shall be on account payments only. The final payment will be made on completion of all the works and on fulfilment by the Contractor of all his liabilities under this contract and also after issue of Completion Certificate by the Agreement Authority.
2. All payments under the Contract shall be in Indian Rupees only.
3. All such interim payments shall be regarded as payment by way of advances against final payment only and shall not preclude the requiring of bad, unsound and imperfect or unskilled work to be rejected, removed, taken away and reconstructed or re-erected. Any certificate given by the Engineer-in-Charge relating to the work done or materials delivered forming part of such payment, may be modified or corrected by any subsequent such certificate(s) or by the final certificate and shall not by itself be conclusive evidence that any work or materials to which it relates is/are in accordance with the contract and specifications. Any such interim payment, or any part thereof shall not in any respect conclude, determine or affect in any way powers of the Engineer-in-Charge under the contract or any of such payments be treated as final settlement and adjustment of accounts or in any way vary or affect the contract.
4. Pending consideration of extension of date of completion, interim payments shall continue to be made as herein provided without prejudice to the right of the department to take action under the terms of this contract for delay in the completion of work, if the extension of date of completion is not granted by the competent authority.
5. The Contractor will be required to produce income-tax and sales tax clearance certificates before the final payment and release of Performance Security Deposits.

Insurance By Contractor : During the performance of Contract hereunder, CONTRACTOR shall take out, carry and maintain insurance as applicable from those listed below:

- a. Contractor shall be responsible for ensuring that professional indemnity insurance exists that would adequately cover contractor exposure to

risks and events of claims, suits, costs, charges, demands, penalties and liabilities arising out of any Contractor's performance of the works. The limit of liability for any one occurrence and in aggregate shall be decided by KSUM and intimated to the CONTRACTOR.

- b. Workman's compensation insurance, covering all employees of CONTRACTOR for statutory benefits as set out and required by local law in the area of operation or area in which CONTRACTOR may become legally obliged to pay benefits for bodily injury or death.
- c. Insurance against fire, theft, damages and loss of all property owned by CONTRACTOR at the construction site.
- d. Group Personal Accident Insurance covering CONTRACTOR's employees not otherwise already covered under sections above, operating from the site as per CONTRACTOR's established practices.
- e. Insurance covering cash in transit/cash in safe/fidelity for all cash transactions performed by CONTRACTOR.
- f. Automobile liability insurance covering all vehicles owned by CONTRACTOR at the project site in accordance with the Motor Vehicles Act.
- g. OTHER INSURANCE : In case KSUM requests CONTRACTOR to obtain any specific insurance on behalf of KSUM; CONTRACTOR shall arrange the same on terms acceptable to KSUM.

VII. Instructions to Bidders

Certificate of incorporation/ partnership deed , work completion certificate from the clients for satisfactory completion of the qualifying work and proof of authorization issued by the original manufacturer (if bidder is authorized dealer). Copy of the work order showing the value and the scope of work. The completion certificate should contain the details such as Name of work, Agreement number, Estimated cost, Contract Price, date of start and date of completion, whether the work has been completed satisfactorily, the salient features of the work like type of work

- b. Certified Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss account to demonstrate its annual financial turnover during the last three financial Years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year. Annual financial turnover and cost of completed works of previous years shall be given a weightage of 5% per year (average annual rate of inflation) to bring them at current price level.
- c. Bidders should submit an undertaking in their own letterhead for meeting the criteria as per Annexure V(Non-Blacklisting)
- d. Bidders should submit declaration as per Annexure IV in company letter head signed and sealed by the authorized signatory.(Declaration on Joint Venture)

WHEREAS the Owner invited Tenders for the work for the **TENDER FOR** proposed Terrace floor and external plumbing rectification works at ISC,KTIZ,Kalamassery AND WHEREAS in the notice inviting Tenders it is stated as follows: Before commencing the work, or within a week of the date when the acceptance of Tender has been intimated to him, the Tenderer shall comply the requirements as per Clause 11 of conditions of contract as security for the proper fulfillment of the same and he shall execute an Agreement for the work in the prescribed form of Agreement. If the Contractor fails to do this or fails to maintain a specified rate of progress, the security deposit shall be forfeited to Owner and fresh Tenders shall be called for or the matter otherwise disposed of.

If as a result of such measures due to the default of the Tenderer to pay the requisite deposit, sign Contracts or take possession of the work any loss to results, the same will be recovered from him as arrears of land revenue but should it be a saving to, the original Contractor shall have no claim whatever to the difference. Recoveries to this or any other account will be made from the sum that may be due to the Contractor on this or any other Contracts or under the Revenue Recovery Act or otherwise as may be decided.

Now therefore these present witnesses and it is mutually agreed as follows:

1.
